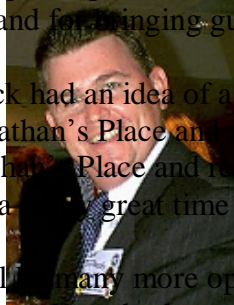
Thanks to all of you
