This Month In History

1892 - The first night football game in the United States was played in Mansfield, Pennsylvania. The game was between Mansfield State Normal School and Wyoming Seminary.

1924 - Two United States Army planes landed in Seattle, Washington, having completed the first round-the-world flight in 175 days.

1955 - The World Series was broadcast in color for the first time.

1961 - On NBC-TV, "Hazel" premiered. The sitcom starred Shirley Booth as Hazel, with Don DeFore as George Baxter and Whitney Blake as Dorothy Baxter, the family who hired Hazel as their maid and housekeeper. "Hazel" was based on Ted Key's "Saturday Evening Post" cartoon series.

1976 - World heavyweight boxing champion Muhammad Ali won a unanimous 15-round decision over Ken Norton at Madison Square Gardens in New York City.

Did You Know?

In 1940, Theodore van Karman, of the National Academy of Science, said jet engines and rockets would be of no future use because there was no material tough enough to stand up under their high combustion temperatures. Karman changed his mind 5 years later. In 1955 he said of his 1940 prediction, "What I did wrong was to write it down."
